## Winterfest and Springfest Fine Arts Festivals

Young at Art is part of Winterfest and Springfest Fine Arts Festivals and is open to any elementary, middle or high school student in Manatee County. Elementary, Middle and High School art work will be judged in separate categories. Ribbons and prizes will be awarded. This exhibit is sponsored in part by the Edward E. and Lillian H. All entries submitted for Winterfest will be displayed at Winterfest, December 10 and 11, 2011. All entries submitted for Springfest will be displayed at Springfest, March 10 and 11, 2012.

Entries will be accepted for each festival according to the following guidelines.

### Entry Guidelines

1. Art must be the original work of the young artist.
2. Any type of two dimensional art work will be accepted.
3. Elementary students must attach their work to a piece of standard sized  
a. (18"X12") black construction paper.
4. Middle and high school students are asked to mat their work.
5. Please print the student's name, age, school, the medium and title of the work on a plain 3"X5" index card and attach to the lower right hand corner of the construction paper. On the back of the piece include contact information to notify the winners.
6. Art work can be submitted to Anna Maria Island Art League from 9:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m., Tuesday - Friday. Or, if teachers wish to collect art work from their students, arrangements can be made for pick up from your school.
7. Winterfest submissions: deadline for submissions is 2:30 p.m. Tuesday December 6, 2011.

Springfest submissions: deadline for submissions is 2:30 p.m. Friday, March 4, 2012.

8. All art work can be picked up at the Art League the week after the festival, during administrative hours: 9:30 a.m. and 2:30 p.m.; Tuesday – Friday.
